Jeans Day

On the last Friday of every month, children are permitted to wear jeans and a jeans day t-shirt.

PTO Jeans Day

Parents must attend the PTO meeting and sign in on the provided sign-in sheet for children to be permitted to wear jeans and a jeans day t-shirt on the Friday following PTO meeting. *See handbook for attire.

Food Fest

This is the day after the PTO meeting where items are available for purchase during each lunch. The typical menu and prices are:

Volunteer Workshop

The volunteer workshop is on the first Wednesday of the month, which is early release day, from 8-11 in the Parish Hall. You are able to obtain hours by aiding the teachers with tasks such as cut/paste/staple/assemble and many other projects for the classrooms.

Restaurant Nights

Local eateries give the school back a percentage of the sales generated during a specific time frame that is designated for CPS. This is a great opportunity to grab a bite and socialize.

Italian Night

Italian dinners are served by the children of CPS as you sit at the beautifully decorated tables in the Parish Hall, or you can do takeout and bring home dinner to your family. Festivities include, but are not limited to, raffles, cake walk, music.

Fall Festival

A night of safe fun and games in the Parish Hall. Dress up & play games for treats and toys with your classmates.

Middle School Dance

A social event for CPS 6th – 8th graders that takes place in the 3rd floor old cafeteria (aftercare room).

Red RibbonWeek

A week dedicated to raise awareness of “Say no to drugs.”

Catholic Schools Week

Various activities and special events throughout the week to celebrate how important it is to be Catholic. Usually ties in with annual registration activities for school in late January and early February.

Oyster Roast

A fundraiser in its third year dedicated to bringing community and school together to enjoy local oysters and other fine foods.

CPS Festival

A big, huge school fundraiser for the community & beyond. Games, rides, performances, fair food & more for three days of fun. This year's festival is February 25 – 27, 2011.

Art Show

A collection and gathering of artwork from every child attending CPS, which is displayed in the cafeteria for all to see. Usually takes place in April or May.

Book Fair

One week of selling books and novelty items that benefit the library. Usually scheduled in November.

New Family Brunch

A gathering of new families to CPS to disperse information and partake in a question and answer session all while enjoying brunch.

Jitterbug Coffee

First day of school get together to talk and relieve any nervousness.

Used Uniform and Book Sale

There are two uniform sales a year. First one is put on only by PTO and is in January right after we switch to wearing pants only instead of shorts. The second one is for everyone to purchase, sell or swap uniforms and textbooks for the upcoming school year. This takes place on the last day of school each year.

Please save at home and send in with your child(ren). We have collection boxes in the classrooms K-5, or you can bring them to the office. CPS receives two cents per packet for recycling.

Box Tops and Label Collections

Scrip

Great Lakes Scrip is back! No more sending home papers to fill out or sending in checks. Everything can be done online at www.GLScrip.com. You must sign up for Presto Pay. This does take a couple of days to become effective, so plan accordingly. Once you set up your family account and submit your Scrip orders, you will receive your Scrip cards within a few days.

An Example of Scrip: If you purchase a \$100 gift card to Macy's , the school will get back \$10.00. We will split that with the purchasing family @ 50%. You would then receive \$5.00 (minus your percentage of shipping cost) in an account that can be used one of three ways:

1. Donate back to CPS
2. Purchase more Scrip cards.
3. Use it towards tuition.

These options are available one time only and it is at the end of the school year.
